We anticipate the opening of the pool to be Saturday May 21st. The pool was just replastered this past week. It will be a few weeks until anyone will be able to use the pool due to the curing process. Once the chemicals have been added and the county has given us the permit, we will open the pool. We also have a new commercial-grade diving board that is going to be installed as soon as it arrives.

Please remember that the pool does have Wi-Fi and a refrigerator. Because of several break-ins last year, the board is considering several new security features including the installation of surveillance cameras.
